National	•Each Country (eg. Australia) will log into SP Membership at the <b>National</b> level
States	<ul> <li>States, Regions and Zones are levels which can be named and configured appropriate. They also don't need to exist in certain circumstances. These levels can view and report on the data below it in the structure</li> </ul>
Regions	•These levels can view and report on the data below it in the structure
Zones	•These levels can view and report on the data below it in the structure
Association/Leagues	The Association level is the highest level to which a member can be direct added and registered to.
Clubs /Teams/ Members	Clubs belong to the Association. A Club can have many Teams     Teams belongs to a Club (Optional) or to an Association
	Members belong to the Association, and to a Club (optional) and a Team (optional). A member will have Transactions, History, Clearances and State
