How do I link a Team form with a Member form?

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Overview

With Passport Registration Forms, Association administrators can set up a continuous team and player registration workflow by linking two forms together, those being:

- A Team to Association Form, and
- A Member to Team Form

Here's an example of how it works:

- John, a team manager for his social team, visits a website and sees an invitation to enter a team into a competition
- John clicks on the link and is taken to a **Team to Association** registration form
- John fills out the form and selects the competition he wishes to join
- After completing the team registration, John can add the email addresses of his friends who will also play on the team. Each friend will then receive an automated email inviting them to join the team
- John's teammates click the link provided in their emails, which launches the linked **Member to Team** registration form
- John, as the team manager, also receives an email prompting him to register with the team

Step-by-Step

Step 1: Navigate to your Registration Form list

From your Association database, click **Registrations** > **REGISTRATION FORMS** in the left-hand menu

Step 2: Edit the relevant Team to Association Form

Find the **Team to Association Form** that you want to use for team registrations, then click **EDIT**

Step 3: Link a Member to Team form

Locate the field titled **Member Form for users to register to teams** and select the applicable **Member to Team** form. This ensures that team managers can invite teammates to register through the linked Member to Team registration form
