

How do I enable Dark Mode in Match Results on a Desktop?

GameDay Passport Match Results allows users to view and navigate the interface using **Dark Mode**, allowing users to view the Passport interface through a darker palette to reduce exposure to blue light and screen brightness, extend battery life and provide an alternative design preference for Passport users.

To toggle between Dark Mode and Light Mode in Passport Match Results:

Click the DARK MODE option
